- 2. Approval of agenda and minutes from January 18, 2021 meeting M/S by Erin/Kendra
- 3. Business Arising: Nothing noted at this time.
- 4. Principal's Report:
  - Engineers came to look at the school, particularly the Kindergarten room. Construction is needed on the South West floor as it has sunk. Action: They will get back to Diahne to discuss next steps. Coming back once snow is gone.
  - School Refresh waiting to hear and be approved from board. Possibly in summer of 2022.
  - School logo/motto 29 respondents from survey, all grades were represented. **Action: Diahne will arrange a committee to review.**
  - 131 students currently attending brick and mortar, currently 41 virtual students. School population in September should be approx. 172 students.
  - Paul Davis hosted a virtual presentation on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for Social Networking Safety for grades 6-8. He will be hosting another in the future for the 4/5 class.
  - Paul Davis also hosted a Social Networking Safety parent/guardian presentation on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The cost was approx. \$450.00 paid for by PRO Grant Funding 20/21. It was a small group. **Action: Diahne and Krista will submit report.**
  - Grade 8 grad fundraising money from 2020 Action: Cheques were sent out to families in the amount of \$64.70 per student, total amount for \$970.55.
  - 2021 Grade 8 graduation Everything quiet from the board. Action: waiting on direction from the board before proceeding/planning. Possible parade (similar to last year, signs, porch photos)
  - Organics program pilot Dan Orr from Northumberland County will be speaking at virtual assembly and dropping containers off March 15<sup>th</sup>. Program is set to start March 26<sup>th</sup>.
  - Mrs. Pearce will be organizing Music Mondays as of May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
  - "Big Crunch" is on Thursday March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 2:30pm for everyone in Canada to "take a bite" to show support for toxic stress caused by the pandemic.
  - Generous donation made to school for purchase of toboggans for kids to use during recess Action: Diahne was in contact with the board and the Health Unit to be able to get this organized.

- Milk Program update numbers are up and it is going very well. Money generated is being donated to school council.
- Nutrition program and popcorn are also doing well.
- Career day Will be held virtually on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Focus will be on the trades.
- Lockdown drill will be held on March 3 (will be modified to hold and secure due to Covid) this is the 2<sup>nd</sup> and last drill of the year.
- Fire drills will be held after the April break with a total of 3 drills.
- Pow wow for 2021 will be held rain or shine, virtual or in person, possibly a video like last year
- Waiting to hear closer to date.

  - Date for Scientists in the classroom will be end of May/1<sup>st</sup> of April, virtual students will be included. Action: Kendra will look into adding names for donations on school cash online.
